## PRESS RELEASE

### **ADJUSTMENT IN PUBLIC TRANSPORT FARES EFFECTIVE FRIDAY, 8<sup>TH</sup> AUGUST, 2025.**

In line with the Administrative Arrangement on Public Transport Fares, the Road Transport Operators have increased public transport fares by **20 percent**. To accommodate:

1. For the non corresponding reduction in spare parts, goods and services after the reduction of transport fares by 15% on 21<sup>st</sup> May, 2025.
2. To accommodate for the increase in operational costs after the introduction of GH¢ 1.00, per liter levy. Ie. About 8% increase in fuel cost.
3. To accommodate for the increase in maintenance cost as a result of the deplorable roads across the country.

**THE NEW FARES TAKE EFFECT FROM FRIDAY, 8<sup>th</sup> AUGUST 2025.** The Fares cover the following types of Road Transport Operations:

1. **SHARED TAXIS**
2. **INTRA CITY (TRO-TRO)**
3. **INTERCITY (LONG DISTANCE)**
4. **HAULAGE**

We kindly request all Commercial Transport Operators / Companies to comply with the new fares and post same at their loading terminals. We further request all Operators, Commuters, and the General Public to cooperate for the successful implementation of the new fares.
